## CONSERVATION OF MANUSCRIPTS

ervation: Any direct or indirect action on a damaged or undamaged manuscript or collection of manuscripts aimed at enhancing the life of the manuscript(s) can be termed as conservation. Preventive Convervation: Any direct or indirect action on a damaged or

undamaged manuscript or collection of manuscripts aired at exhancing the life of the manuscript(s) by reducing future risks of deterioration can be termed as preventive conservation. For example: Regular inspection of the condition of the collection, deputing staff for training in preventive

Curretive Conservation: Any direct action on a damaged manuscript or collection of manuscripts aimed at stopping active deterioration in the manuscript(s) can be termed as curnive conservation. For example: Furnigation of a manuscript collection that has live inaccts in it. Renteration: Any direct action on a damaged manascript aimed at

improving the visual aspect of the manuscript can be termed as restoration. For example: Removing poncil marks from a manuscript folio.
