Synopsis of Talks of Resource Persons:

Dr. Victor Babu Koppula: "Indian Philosophy with the Reference of African Mind"

Prof. (Dr.) Rajkumar Modak: "Some of the Basic Ancient Indian Scientific & Spiritual Approaches and Their Need to Cope Up with the Environmental Crises"

Prof. Rajkumar Modak, from Sidho-Kanho-Birsha University, delivered a comprehensive lecture on ancient Indian scientific and spiritual approaches to cope with environmental crises. He discussed the fundamental components of the universe according to Indian philosophy, emphasizing the intrinsic value of nature. Prof. Modak explored the relevance of ancient Indian wisdom in addressing contemporary ecological challenges. He underscored the need for integrating concepts like sauch (purity), sadācāra (ethical behavior), śradha (faith), and nistraiguņya (equilibrium) for environmental sustainability.
