Report

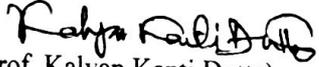

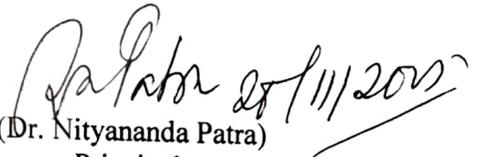

Title of the programme: Poster Making (Using AI) and Presentation

Organised by: Bizonomics Club Members

Report

The Bizonomics Club successfully hosted a multi-faceted event focused on studying and showing details about India's 'Rural Economy'. This event smartly mixed classroom learning via poster displays with real-world practice through small business stalls. Attendees learned a lot about three important rural economy areas while also trying out business ideas based on crafts and handmade items.

The event seamlessly integrated educational and experiential components:

1. **Poster Making Using AI:** Participants developed visually compelling posters and information graphics using AI tools (e.g., Gemini/ChatGPT). The focus was on effective visual design and data representation to highlight key insights and complex issues of the rural economy.
2. **Poster Presentation:** Teams presented their research and visual analysis to the judges and attendees, demonstrating their ability to convey complex economic concepts clearly.

3. **Mini-Business Stalls (Experiential Learning):** Club members set up and managed stalls featuring two distinct product categories: handmade cards and artisanal jewellery pieces. This activity provided practical exposure to inventory management, marketing, sales, and the realisation that traditional skills hold modern market value.

The event was guided by Dr. Kamalika Chakraborty (Head of the Department of Economics), Prof. Kalyan Kanti Dutta (Head of the Department of Commerce), and Dr. Varuna Agarwala (Assistant Professor, Department of Commerce).

Objectives

The multi-faceted event was designed with the following core objectives:

- **Educational Awareness:** To educate participants about key socio-economic issues within the rural economy, focusing on: a) The employment scenario of rural women, b) Banking habits and financial inclusion in rural areas and c) The use and impact of digital platforms in rural contexts.
- **Interdisciplinary and Experiential Learning:** To foster interdisciplinary understanding by combining theoretical economic analysis with practical business application.
- **Entrepreneurial Skill Development:** To provide hands-on experience in small-scale entrepreneurship through the setup and management of operational mini-business stalls.

The event successfully delivered on its objectives, resulting in the following key outcomes for the attendees:

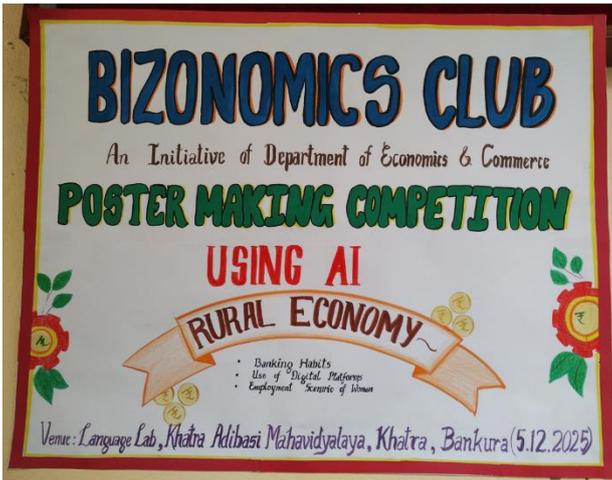
